

Call for proposals for training events to be supported by Laserlab-Europe

Laserlab-Europe invites proposals for user training schools or training events, to be co-organized by Laserlab-Europe under the work package Human Resources Development, Task: Cooperation with existing training programmes.

Objectives:

- Development and training of new User communities with no or little past experience in using lasers in their research;
- Attracting and training of new users from new scientific communities (e.g. life sciences) in a multi-disciplinary perspective.

Guidelines for proposals:

Proposals should contain the following information:

- Event title
- Proposed date(s) and place
- Name and contact information of the organizer
- Brief description of the training goals and topics and the targeted audience
- Preliminary training format and proposed schedule
- Estimated number of participants
- Brief description of potential Laserlab involvement and benefit
- Cost estimate

* Co-funding may be up to EUR 3000.

* Deadline for proposals: **31 October 2014**
